Dr. Ethan D. Schafer is a licensed child psychologist. He graduated Phi Beta Kappa from the University of Michigan in 1998, with High Honors in psychology. In 2004, he received his doctorate in clinical child psychology from Case Western Reserve University in Cleveland, where he teaches graduate courses on psychological assessment of children, clinical supervision, and psychological consultation, and undergraduate courses on abnormal child psychology and human sexual behavior. He is the consulting psychologist and directs the Psychological Assessment Center at Lawrence School, an independent school for bright children with learning differences. He is also the consulting psychologist at University School's Middle School, a private school for boys. Dr. Schafer also co-owns a private practice, where he works primarily with adolescent patients who have mood and anxiety disorders.

Dr. Schafer has over 25 years of camp experience, as a camper, counselor, and consultant. He has been consulting with summer camps across the country since 2003 and is a frequent presenter at regional and national conferences. Dr. Schafer's staff training workshops focus on helping counselors develop practical, scientifically-supported skills to work effectively with campers of all ages and backgrounds.
